### El Paso County Bar Association Referral Service:

The Referral Service will provide you with the name and number of one or more attorneys who practice in the local area and who have experience in the field which pertains to your legal issues. These are private attorneys and charge retainer and attorney fees. You can shop around for the attorney which you like the best. Do not hesitate to ask the attorneys what their hourly fee is when you call for the first time. Some may offer an initial consultation free of charge.
