COLONEL RANDALL C. DUNCAN

Col Duncan is the Director of the Peterson Area Dental Laboratory (ADL), ADOS Squadron, Peterson AFB, Colorado. This laboratory is the largest in the Air Force, is one of three full-service dental laboratories designated by HQ USAF/SGOD and is the only Air Force ADL located in CONUS, providing support for 343 Department of Defense dental facilities. Col Duncan is the Military Consultant to the Surgeon General for Dental Laboratories, providing clinical consultant services on treatment planning of complex patient care, laboratory consultant services on manufacturing dental prostheses and devices, annual continuing education workshops for dentists and laboratory technicians, and publishing information letters on clinical and technical procedures for Air Force dental clinics and laboratories.
