General Course Information

- Airman Leadership School (ALS) consists of 24 academic duty days. The normal duty hours are 0730-1630 except for **day zero which starts at 0800.**
- Uniform of the day is as follows: Monday will be Service Uniform. Tuesday through Friday will be ABUs. Please ensure you have your Full Service Dress Uniform, to include Service Coat, ready at all times.
- Members are required to uphold all Dress and Personal Appearance Standards according to AFI 36-2903. *Your ribbons and badges must be worn each day when wearing the service uniform.*
- The Icebreaker will be located at the Club.
- Tobacco use is prohibited during school duty hours (AFI 40-102 para 2.2.8).

Day Zero

- Report to Peterson AFB Airman Leadership School, Bldg 1141, 2nd floor, in civilian attire, on the **day prior to your class start date (CSD).**
- All students will go through in-processing and orientation in the morning. All study guides and student materials will be provided.
- Bring copies of any applicable waivers.
- Bring a copy of your current PT assessment.
- Please bring a writing instrument/highlighter and paper for note taking.
