Top Five Article 15 Offenses

- Use of I, II, or III controlled substances
 - Heroin, LSD, Marijuana, Ecstasy, Oxycodone, Percocet, Morphine, Opium.
- Wrongful use of marijuana.
- Violation of other general order.
- Failure to obey lawful order.
- Dereliction of duty: Willful.

Colorado DUI/DWAI Laws

- Driving While Ability Impaired (DWAI):
 - BAC .05 or above but less than .08
- Driving Under the Influence (DUI):
 - BAC .08 or above
- Includes prescription drugs and controlled substances.

Gun Laws

- Concealed carry is allowed only off base with permit granted by county sheriff.
- Housing residents must register firearms within 72 hours of arrival or purchase/possession.
- Dorm residents are required to store firearms in base armory.

Adultery

- Violation of the UCMJ, Article 134
- Directly prejudicial to good order and discipline or service discrediting

- Effects unit discipline, morale, and cohesion

-Effects reputation of the Armed Forces
