

## USEFUL WEBSITES

System for Award Management (SAM): <https://www.sam.gov>. SAM includes the functionality of four systems: 1) Central Contractor Registry (CCR); 2) Federal Agency Registration (Fedreg); 3) Online Representations and Certifications Application; and 4) Excluded Parties List System (EPLS). It is **MANDATORY** for all companies to be registered in SAM before they can receive a Government contract award. During the registration process you will be assigned a CAGE Code and DUNS number unique to your company. If you need assistance with registration, contact your local Procurement Technical Assistance Center (PTAC) (<http://www.aptac-us.org/>) and they can help with the process.

Wide Area Workflow (WAWF): <https://wawf.eb.mil>. WAWF is a secure web-based system for electronic invoicing, receipt, and acceptance. It enables electronic form submission of invoices, government inspection, and acceptance documents for payment in respect to contract performance. All DoD agencies use WAWF (with a few exceptions). All companies **MUST** create a WAWF account in accordance with DFARS Clause 252.232-7003 Electronic Submission of Payment Requests and Receiving Reports.

US Small Business Administration: <https://www.sba.gov/>. This website provides small businesses information and services based on a company’s unique business needs. The SBA helps Americans start, build, and grow businesses. SBA provides assistance primarily through four programmatic functions: 1) Access to Capital (Business Financing); 2) Entrepreneurial Development (Education, Information, Technical Assistance, and Training); 3) Government Contracting (Federal Procurement); and 4) Advocacy (Voice for Small Business). SBA provides assistance to small businesses on how to get started, contracting support, and understanding the Federal market place.

The Air Force purchases all network-centric solutions through NETCENTS 2 contract vehicles (with a few exceptions) and all computers and monitors through the AFWay program (with a few exceptions).
